

WTU Exemplary Local School Union Leadership & Get Back Partial Dues Program Application

Deadline: November 30, 2016

Program Overview and Guidelines

The Washington Teachers' Union invites all Building Representatives to participate in the new WTU Exemplary Local School Union Leadership program. Elected Building Representatives who are full dues paying union members and exhibit highly effective union leadership skills as evidenced through a portfolio submission, will be selected to receive 100% of their union dues paid to the Washington Teachers' Union during the 2016-2017 school year.

We are seeking exemplary Building Representatives who take an active role in enforcing the WTU/DCPS Collective Bargaining Agreement, developing and sustaining positive and high-functioning union teams, influencing the instructional program at the local school level, and creating a professional work and learning environment as a:

- 1. **School Leader** exemplifies high professional standards; provides professional resources and support; and plays a key role in school improvement
- 2. **Union Builder** —contacts members on a regular, ongoing basis; reaches out to new employees; builds an active union team; and develops new leaders
- 3. **Communicator** —shares the union message; establishes two-way communication; and uses active listening skills
- 4. **Problem Solver** —addresses worksite problems at early stages; understands and applies the contract accurately; and uses conflict resolution, problem solving model and/or consensus when appropriate

Program Expectations

Building Representatives (BR) selected for this program and incentive will:

• Attend a minimum of 7 Representative Assembly and/or General Membership meetings, held every second Tuesday, McKinley Technology HS, 4:30-6:30 pm; BR or Alternate Delegate attendance required



- Attend a minimum of four (4) Regional meetings held every fourth Tuesday with your Field Representative (check for monthly location)
- Maintain an updated WTU Bulletin Board in the main office during the school year
- Facilitate two (2) LSAT meetings with all elected and/or appointed officials in collaboration with school administration
- Attend a minimum of two (2) Union Leadership Institute (ULI) trainings on select Saturdays various locations
- Meet all WTU Elections deadlines by May 31st
- Maintain 80% full dues paying status school-wide for the 2016-17 school year
- Hold four (4) Chapter meetings (can combine staff meeting with chapter meetings where and when applicable) as well as four (4) SCAC meetings

The application is due no later than November 30, 2016. Late application submissions will NOT be accepted. If you have any questions or would like additional information, please contact your field representative or email: <u>dialogue@wtulocal6.net</u>.

All portions of the application must be submitted or the application will be considered incomplete: (1) Application; (2) Commitments; (3) Short Essay; and (4) one letter of recommendation. Responses may be submitted as a separate Word document and attachment to the application.
